Arrival/Check In:

Upon arrival, at bus check-in, inside your packets you will receive wrist bands for all performers and 10 separate wrist bands for Pit Crew members/chaperones ONLY. Please inform your helpers this is a fund raiser and we would appreciate their cooperation in this matter. All other helpers/chaperones must purchase an admission wrist band at the main entrance to the stadium.

Any parents/pit crew members will be allowed entrance into the stadium to help move equipment/props. HOWEVER please be advised that they will not be permitted back into the stadium without a proper wrist band. Either they will have one of the wrist bands given out from the Director's packet at the director's discretion or they can purchase a general admission wrist band on the south side of the stadium.

ADMISSION:

Tickets will be available at the South Side ticket booth for the price of **\$8.00, General Admission, children 12 and under, \$5.00 and children 3 and under are free.**

ANNOUNCER:

An announcer is already provided for you. If you did not submit your pre and post script with your application, please bring it with you to bus check-in.

CONCESSION STAND:

A variety of food and beverages will be on sale to your students, chaperones and band parents. Please ADVISE your students and parents that these items will be sold on the South Side of the stadium. **THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO ICE CHESTS IN THE CHAFFEY HIGH SCHOOL STADIUM or parking lot. THE CHAFFEY HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS PROHIBITS COOKING/FOOD PREPARATION IN THEIR PARKING LOTS.**

We have amazing snack bars set up for you with very reasonable prices. This is a fundraiser event and we encourage all participants to support the Chaffey High School Marching Tigers by purchasing food at the concession stands in the stadium.

PROGRAMS:

Programs will be on sale at the South side of the stadium and in our stadium at the cost of only \$3.00 per program.

SEATING CHART: You will receive a seating chart at check-in and the seats on the home side will be marked with your band's name. Please be advised and remind your students of appropriate behavior in the stands. **Any misbehavior in the stands before, during or after other band performances can result in asking your group to leave.** Please make sure they act accordingly. Seating on the away side is open seating.

Artificial Turf Stadium Rules

There are a few changes that have been made in order to ensure our beautiful new artificial turf stays protected. **No gas-powered vehicles without an oil pan will be permitted on the track, no exceptions. No heels** will be permitted on the track as well, so please inform your helpers of this change! Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. It is greatly appreciated.

BUS/TRUCK PARKING:

Bus parking will occur off of the main 4th Street stadium parking lot (see directions page). There will be room for your buses, equipment truck/semi and **TWO support vehicles**. All other vehicles **MUST PARK IN SPECTATOR PARKING**. Spaces for buses and support vehicles are limited. We cannot guarantee room for pop-up tents or tables. Overflow bus/truck parking will be off of vine (see map)

SPECTATOR PARKING:

Spectator parking is available on the **North Side** of the stadium, off of 5th Street and Euclid. Spectators can walk through North Quad to get to the entrance of the stadium.

PERCUSSION EQUIPMENT:

Please make sure you have adequate staff/ pit people assist in moving your percussion equipment to and from performing areas. Please call me directly if you need our help. We will not be supplying any vehicle support for pit transportation, but we can supply plenty of manpower. =) We ask that all pit percussion sections arrive at least ONE band prior to your groups scheduled performance time.

ADJUDICATION FORMS:

We will be using the SCSBOA "Caption Sheets." **NOTE: Please review all the new rules and regulations, especially in regards to time permitted on the field. They can be found on the SCSBOA website.**

AWARDS CEREMONY:

Please send your leaders to the band entry gate on the Performers side (South East Side of the stadium) immediately after the last band's performance.

WARM UP:

Full band warm-up, color guard warm-up and percussion warm-ups can be done in the South quad area, east of the stadium, or any area east of the stadium. Instruments must face away from the stadium (East). You may warm up in any of these areas as long as you wish. **It is YOUR responsibility to move to the final staging area on time. (SOUTH- EAST END OF THE STADIUM).** LATE ARRIVAL TO THE PERFORMANCE FIELD WILL RESULT IN PENALTIES ADHERING TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCSBOA GUIDELINES. ANY UNIT IN THE STAGING AREA OR ANY OTHER AREA OTHER THAN THE WARM UP AREA, WHICH INTERFERES WITH A COMPETING UNIT DURING THEIR PERFORMANCE, MAY BE GIVEN A PENALTY OFF THE BAND SHEET. THIS PENALTY MAY BE GIVEN AFTER THE FIRST WARNING AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT WARNING.

HOSPITALITY:

There will be a section on the EAST END OF THE STADIUM for Band Directors and Staff personnel ONLY, to rest up and enjoy some delicious food!!! Please advise your organization that this is a PRIVATE area to all Band Directors and staff.

Directions for Buses/Equipment Trucks

Chaffey High School
1245 North Euclid Avenue
Ontario, Ca. 91762

From the 60 Freeway:

1. Take the 60 Freeway to Mountain Avenue (Montclair)
2. Head North on Mountain Avenue to 4th Street
3. Turn Right (east)
4. Take 4th Street past Vine avenue. Bus parking will be in the main stadium parking lot, on your left. Watch for signs and guides.

From the 10 Freeway

1. Take the 10 Freeway to Mountain Avenue (Montclair)
2. Head South on Mountain to 4th Street
3. Turn Left (east)
4. Take 4th Street past Vine avenue; Bus parking will be in the main stadium parking lot, on your left. Watch for signs and guides.

From the 210 Freeway

1. Take the 210 Freeway to Mountain Avenue (Montclair)
2. Head South on Mountain to 4th Street
3. Turn Left (east)
4. Take 4th Street past Vine avenue; Bus parking will be in the main stadium parking lot, on your left. Watch for signs and guides.

Spectator parking is off of 5th Street this year. With all sets of directions, spectators just need to turn onto 5th, rather than 4th street. The spectator parking is between Euclid and Vine, on the North side of the street.

Note: WE HAVE CHANGED OUR BUS PARKING THIS YEAR!! Please inform your bus drivers to proceed to Mountain Avenue and 4th street, past Vine- not 5th Street!! Please also remind them to proceed to Mountain Avenue and to not turn down Euclid. Thanks for your help!!
