Once again, to facilitate the registration process this year, we are emailing the registration forms packet for your convenience. Click here (control & click) for the welcome and calendar, and click here (control & click) for the registration packet. (Color Guard, you will have a different Uniform Agreement that will be emailed under separate cover to you.)

PLEASE NOTE: REGISTRATION AND UNIFORM MEASUREMENTS will happen ON AUGUST 5TH, 4-8pm, BEFORE BAND CAMP. Bring your student with you. Do not wait until band camp to submit your registration.

This year we are encouraging you to submit your completed registration packets before band camp by either:

- 1) Scanning your packet to a pdf file, emailing it and submitting your payment via:
 - PayPal Online (see the website) (please add 3% service charge to your payment); or
 - Drop a check off to the black box on one of the open band room days below; or
 - Bring your check or credit card on August 5th to make a quick payment at registration
- 2) Dropping the packet **and** payment off in the black box in the band room which will be open from 9am-12pm on Tuesday, 7/30, and Thursday, 8/1.

If you prefer to bring your packet and payment to registration, you certainly may.

Registration will begin at 4pm on Monday, August 5th.

We try to get students through the registration line as quickly as possible.

THE DISTRICT LIABILITY POLICY REQUIRES THAT EACH STUDENT RECEIVE A PRE-PARTICIPATION PHYSICAL AND COMPLETE ALL FORMS BEFORE HE OR SHE WILL BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN FIELD ACTIVITIES. THIS POLICY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED THIS YEAR.

STUDENTS WILL BE UNABLE TO ATTEND THE FIRST FOOTBALL GAME ON SEPTEMBER 13th WITHOUT:

- A completed, signed permission form (the first form in your packet) AND
- A completed, signed and Dr. stamped physical form AND
- A copy of the front and back of the student's insurance card

Please double check the instructions in your packet to make sure that you have every document **filled out completely and signed**. The registration stations should be in about the same order as the forms. Include payment for your transportation, uniform items and your Fair Share Donation payable to El Dorado Band Boosters. The fair share participation contribution is due on August 5th. However, if you need to work out a payment plan, please contact the Financial Secretary at finance@eldoradoband.com. We also offer PayPal or direct bank transfer options.

UPDATES TO PREVIOUS MARCHING SEASON COSTS

Ideally, all costs will be paid for at or before registration, but we've also included deadlines for some payments that will be required for students to participate.

The breakdown of this year's student costs are as follows:

Transportation: \$125

The transportation fee must be paid for student to be granted entry onto the bus for the first football game on Friday, September 13th.

<u>Under-uniform Items</u>:

Under Armour shirt	\$15
Shorts	\$10
Shoes	\$40
Show Shirt	\$15
Glove Kit (non-percussion only)	\$10
Uniform item total:	\$90

Band Polo Shirt \$35

Polo shirts are worn by students at various bandrelated events. If you are a returning student, you don't need to purchase one unlessyou've outgrown or lost yours.

Payment for uniform items is required before the uniform items are distributed to students sometime in September.

Fair Share Contribution: \$600

Fundraising Buyout: \$250

The program holds a variety of fundraising events during the school year to help keep costs low. Participation is needed from every student in order to be successful in offsetting costs. If you'd rather not participate in selling tickets for fundraising during the year, you may opt out of selling tickets with this amount. Volunteer hours are still needed by students and parents alike.

Here are some NEW STUDENT potential payment amounts:

Transportation and uniform items and polo purchase:	\$ 250
Transportation, uniform, polo and fair share payment (no fundraising buyout)	\$ 850
Full payment for required items plus fair share and fundraising buyout	\$1,100

And here are some RETURNING STUDENT potential payment amounts:

Transportation, shoes, gloves, and show shirt purchase:	\$ 190
Transportation, shoes, gloves, show shirt and fair share payment (no buyout)	\$ 790
Transportation, shoes, gloves, show shirt, and fair share and buyout	\$ 1,040

Don't forget, your Fair Share Participation Contributions are Tax Deductible! The Treasurer can provide tax donation letters at the end of the year, if requested. And if any of your employers offer charitable donation matching, we also qualify for those programs and would appreciate any corporation donations!

Most Common Missing Items/Mistakes in Registration Paperwork

- Missing copy of insurance card
- Not circling t-shirt size for show shirt on the Uniform Agreement
- Do you want your student to ride on the bus? Then check the "District Bus" box AND the Commercial Charter box on the Parent Permission form. (Jazz Band, Color Guard and Winter Drumline Students should also check the box "Private Auto Driven by Parent".)
