BAND UNIFORM AGREEMENT

Marching Uniform

The Band Marching Uniform consists of a jacket, bib-pants, garment bag, hat and hatbox. These items will be issued to the student. The Marching Uniform is the property of El Dorado High School. It is the responsibility of each student to use care when handling, wearing and storing their issued uniform. Damage due to lack of proper care will result in a replacement cost charge of \$500. The Marching Uniforms are kept and cared for at El Dorado High School and do not go home with the student.

Student Appearance

Hair – hair must be either SHORT ENOUGH to be above the collar of the Marching Uniform or LONG ENOUGH to pull up into the hat. Facial Hair – Boys must be clean shaven for all performances, including sideburns.

Jewelry/Makeup

All visible piercings must be removed – they may not be covered up.

NO JEWELRY - NO NAIL POLISH - NO EXCEPTIONS

BAND "WHITES"

All Marching Band students must have band "whites" (see below) to wear under the Marching Uniform – they are required for fittings and performances. These items are purchased, owned and cared for by each Marching Band student. All but socks will be purchased through the band. Purchasing 3-packs of socks will ensure the student has clean socks for days and weeks with multiple performances – the socks should be long black nylon or nylon-blend socks – NO LOGO.

PLEASE NOTE: The first three items below are a mandatory part of the marching uniform for all band members. New students need to purchase all items. It is also recommended that returning students purchase new gloves, as last year's gloves are likely dingy. Gloves do not need to be purchased for Drummers and Front Ensemble members.

-Band Shorts

Shorts must be worn under the marching uniform. This year, all students will be measured for standard-issue long, black athletic shorts. Shorts are ordered by the Uniform Committee – purchased, owned and cared for by each student. Multiple pairs may be purchased.

-Under Armour Band Shirts

Shirts must be worn under the marching uniform. Students will be sized for a standard-issue black, wicking/quick drying athletic type t-shirt. Shirts are ordered by the Uniform Committee – purchased, owned and cared for by each student. Multiple shirts may be purchased.

-Shoes

Shoes are ordered by the Uniform Committee – purchased, owned and cared for by each student. Returning students, check sizing and wear.

<u>-Glove Kit</u> – (Front Ensemble and Non-Parade Drummers are exempt)

The glove kit consists of 2 pairs of gloves. Gloves are purchased, owned, cared for and kept track of by each student.

-Polos for New Members

These are worn when not in uniform at competition events and football games.
