Instrument Weekly Checks

It is each student's responsibility and the expectation of our program, to make sure each instrument is in good working order/cleaned frequently.

All Brass must have all slides, valves, and mouthpieces cleaned and oiled appropriately. Silver Brass must be polished. See Mr. Smith for silver polish or get your own from <u>Amazon Here!</u>

All Woodwinds must have 2-3 working reeds at each rehearsal/performance. Please date each reed with a marker. (For example, if you open a new reed today, write 9/22 on the stock of the reed).

Here are some <u>good reed case</u> options for

not too much money. <u>Altos/Clarinets</u>, <u>Tenor</u> <u>Sax/Bass Clarinet/Bari Sax</u>.

There are other fun options as well like <u>these</u> <u>colored options.</u> Try to get something that holds at least 2-4 reeds, is flat, and protects them from breaking.

*Optional - Also a great deal right now are <u>WW mouthpiece pads</u>.

Something is better than nothing however please have these items ready for your instrument check. You will receive 10 points for a working/cleaned instrument at these checks. These are graded assignments.
