All Woodwinds must have 2-3 working reeds at each rehearsal/performance. Please date each reed with a marker. (For example, if you open a new reed today, write 9/22 on the stock of the reed).

Here are some good reed case options for not too much

money. <u>Altos/Clarinets</u>, <u>Tenor Sax/Bass</u> <u>Clarinet/Bari Sax</u>.

Something is better than nothing however please have these items ready for your instrument check. You will receive 10


